This net meets every **Monday** night at **1900** hours (7pm) local time on **146.460** MHz simplex.

The bulletin is transmitted digitally at 1855 on this frequency using the MSK-2000L protocol in the FM mode.

Everyone listening is encouraged to check in and participate in tonight's net. Also, everyone is encouraged to be Net Control in the future.

- 1- Is there any **emergency** or **priority traffic** for the net?
- 2- Any **announcements** for the net?
- 3- If you need to **break in** with **emergency** traffic, a **relay**, **information** or a **question** feel free to break in with your **callsign**.
- 4- Are there any **mobile stations** wishing to check in?
- 5- Any **stations** operating on **emergency** or **alternative power**?
- 6- Here is the list as I have it.....(call the roster)
- 7- Any **late** or **missed** stations?
- 8- Any **visitors**?
- 9- Repeat **announcements**, info.
- 10-**Last call** for late, missed or visiting stations.
- 11-Hearing none, this is (name), (callsign) **closing** the Monday night Eureka ARES Net and **releasing this frequency** to regular Amateur use.

Move to 146.760 (FWRA link) at 1930 to report totals to the DEC
